SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (Year B)

Mary, Mother of God

May is traditionally dedicated in a special way to honouring and seeking the intercession of Mary as the Mother of God and Mother of the Church.

"She is that woman who rejoiced in the presence of God, who treasured everything in her heart, and who let herself be pierced by the sword. Mary is the saint among the saints, blessed above all others. She teaches us the way of holiness and she walks ever at our side. She does not let us remain fallen and at times she takes us into her arms without judging us." Pope Francis, Gaudete et Exsultate, no. 176

As the Mother of God, the Virgin Mary has a unique position among the Saints, indeed, among all creatures. She is exalted, yet still one of us. As Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI reflected in Deus Caritas Est (Dec. 2005), "Outstanding among the Saints is Mary, Mother of the Lord and **mirror of all holiness**. Mary's greatness consists in the fact that she wants to magnify God, not herself. She is lowly: **her only desire is to be the handmaid of the Lord** (cf. Lk 1:38, 48)."

Mary, more than anyone, can show us Jesus, lead us to him and teach us to know and love him, "so that we too can become capable of true love and be fountains of living water in the midst of a thirsting world."

The month of May is also dedicated to recognizing mums, grandmothers, stepmums, mothers-to-be and all women who, in and through their lives, **encompass the qualities of motherhood.** It's also important to realize that Mother's Day can be difficult or painful for women who struggle with infertility, the loss of a child or children, or who are estranged from their own mothers. May the grace of God fill our hearts and bring comfort and hope to our souls.

HOW VISIBLE ARE OUR PARISH VALUES?

Joyful – Inclusive – Inspirational – Loving - Christ-centred – Authentic "A joyful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones." Proverbs 17:22

Joy is a feeling of good pleasure and happiness that is dependent on who Jesus is, rather than on who we are, or what is happening around us. Joy comes from the Holy Spirit, abiding in God's presence and from hope in His word.

Joy is a deeper emotion than happiness that comes from a sense of purpose and meaning, including finding meaning in suffering — and from relationships with others.

The simple acronym for **JOY** is putting **J**esus first, followed by **O**thers and putting **Y**ourself last. Being **JOYFUL** is an attitude of gratitude and of finding delight and a feeling beyond happiness in serving God and others.

How can each of us be JOYFUL in our parish community? How can we bring JOY to others? Our parish mission calls us to serve Jesus as we serve others.
